Abbey Community College Uniform Clarification

In Abbey Community College, our uniform brings uniformity and equality and develops a sense of belonging in the students' minds and in the minds of the community. When wearing the uniform, students represent our school and should take pride in being a member of the Abbey community.

Please note the following clarifications around our school uniform:

- **Students without full uniform must present themselves with a note of explanation from their parent/guardian to the Principal, Deputy Principals or their Year Head before 8.40 am.**
- Sanctions will follow if students do not have a valid explanation as per our Code of Behaviour.
- Students who persistently breach school uniform rules will not be allowed into class. Parents/Guardians will be asked to collect them from school.
- The attached poster is hung in every classroom as a visual for students and staff.
- All staff when taking their roll **during period 1 will check school uniform.**
- If a student is not wearing the correct uniform in period 1, that student will be immediately sent to the relevant Deputy Principal.

P.E Uniform

- P.E Uniform can be worn for the entire school day by students partaking in P.E on their timetable that day.
- P.E Uniform consists of a crested polo shirt and half-zip and navy tracksuit bottoms.
- **No alternative sweatshirts / hoodies can be worn for P.E.**
- School tracksuit bottoms or plain navy tracksuit bottoms must be worn. **Leggings, striped or branded tracksuit bottoms are not permitted.**

During Cold Weather in Covid Times

- Students are encouraged to wear base layers to keep warm during periods of colder weather.
- Students may wear their school crested half-zip under or over their school jumper as an extra layer.
- **No alternative sweatshirts / hoodies can be worn in school.**
- If a coat is required due to low temperatures due to windows and doors open for ventilation, students can wear a coat (**not a sweatshirt/hoody**) over their school crested uniform.
