Pay by Text Message

A payment request is sent to the nominated mobile for each student. Click and pay in 3 easy steps:

- 1) Choose a bill to pay
- 2) Tick T&C and Pay by Card Online
- 3) Enter card details on secure banking system

The following bills are owing each year by students:

- 1) Book Rental fee €90 which includes consumable classroom materials and Student Record Book (for students participating the Book Rental scheme).
- 2) Fees for TY students (payable in two instalments)
- 3) Evening Study fees (priority given to 3rd years and 6th years)
- 4) Fees for LCA (Leaving Cert. Applied) students
- 5) Family Contribution – this is a voluntary contribution towards 24/7, 365 for compulsory insurance, communication with home, contribution towards bus costs and also helps to develop further opportunities and resources for students. Contribution is as follows:
 - a) €70 per student
 - b) €120 per family
