ABOUT US: Foróige have been working in the Ferrybank community for over 20 years, running fun, interesting and developmental groups that give young people a place to hang out, be themselves and mature in a safe and welcoming environment. All our weekly groups are free of charge.

We run our Drop In Youth Cafe every Friday after school for young people living in Ferrybank & the surrounding area. There are two different times for 1st years, one is straight after school from 1:00 – 2:15pm and the other is 3.00 – 4.00 p.m. Foróige Drop In is simply a hangout space for young people to relax after school in a warm friendly safe environment. We have lots of places for people to sit and chat as well as Wi-Fi, music, an Xbox, a Nintendo switch, a Nintendo Wii, a pool table an air hockey table, board games a very cheap snack shop, games, competitions and loads more. It happens every Friday after school in the Ferrybank Parish Centre and on most school holidays also.

Additionally, from Monday to Thursday we run other groups. On Monday evenings we have a soccer group where we get together for a fun game of football & a kick around in a pressure free environment. We also run lots of other small groups throughout the week where we work on projects such as Homework clubs, Art, film making, raising money for charity etc. and discuss learn /about topics such as bullying, mental & physical health, hygiene, online safety, building social skills & loads more.
