Dear Parent / Guardian,

The Transition Year students will be travelling to Delphi Adventure Centre, Co. Mayo from 14th - 16th March.

Departure: 7.00 am **sharp** Monday March 14th 2022

Return: 5.00 pm approx. Wednesday March 16th 2022

Students will need to bring a packed lunch for Monday and any snacks they require. Dinner, breakfast and lunch will be provided for Tuesday and Wednesday. As we will be embarking on a very long bus journey to and from the venue, we discourage the use of fizzy drinks and junk snacks/food.

Students need to pack appropriate clothes suitable for Irish weather! Please see recommendation for packing as outlined in the Delphi Adventure Centre parent/guardian information distributed in early February. The list is also posted on the TY Year Group Team. Students **are required to wear their school PE uniform**. They will be participating in outdoor activities where they will get wet and dirty. Please do not bring good clothes or valuables. Teachers are not responsible for personal items or money belonging to the students. **Please read carefully the Parents Guide for Delphi Resort which you signed a few weeks ago. A sleeping bag and pillow are not required.**

All school rules, as outlined in our school's *Code of Behaviour* must be adhered to at all times. Students must comply with all instructions given by teachers and instructors while on the adventure in line with Abbey Community College's *School Tour Policy*. Any serious breach of the school's *Code of Behaviour* will result in the student having to be collected immediately by a parent/guardian. **Please read and discuss the [Code of Behaviour](#) with your son/daughter. In particular please note the following:**

Any misuse of mobile phones or personal electronic devices will be dealt with under the *Mobile Phone, and Personal Electronic Device Acceptable Use Policy* and our *Code of Behaviour*. It is a criminal offence to use an electronic device to menace, harass, or offend another person. The school* may consider it appropriate to involve the Gardai in such incidents. (School* in this context refers to during school time/school activities both on and off-site at any time.)

On the recommendation of Delphi Adventure Centre students' phones will be collected upon arrival to the centre to facilitate participation in activities. They will be returned to the students between 9pm & 10pm approx. each evening and then collected before bedtime.
