### 5<sup>th</sup> Year School Tour to Italy

Dear Parents/Guardians,

As we approach our departure for the tour, we would like to remind you of the following:

The dimensions for carry-on luggage are **55cm X 40cm X 24cm**. The maximum weight of this bag is **10kg**. One **small** personal item is also permitted (i.e. a small handbag/backpack). If a student brings a bag that is too big, they will have to pay the necessary fees to check in that bag. The following list covers items that are restricted for carriage on board Air Lingus flights as hand luggage:

Aerosols (spray deodorants) are banned.

Gels (hair gel, moisturizers etc.) are banned.

Sharp objects (scissors, razors, nail clippers etc.) are banned.

Liquids are limited 100ml or less (shampoo, conditioner, perfume, nail polish, make-up etc.). These must be placed in a special clear plastic bag at Dublin Airport.

All students must ensure they pack **all medication needed** for the duration of the trip (inhalers, epipens, antihistamines etc.)

Students should bring **sun cream**, a light jacket, **comfortable flat shoes**, and expect changes in the weather. Students should **dress appropriately** at all times as you are representing our school.

Please note there are some **essential costs** while in Italy:

- A good behaviour bond of €10 per student from the hotel (refundable on departure).
- Locker in Gardaland (€5 approximately).
- Their own lunch each day in Verona, Venice, Gardaland and after the cable car.
- Food in the airport (departing and returning).

Please bear in mind that airport breakfasts can be very expensive so they may bring a packed breakfast (no drinks) to eat in the airport. Students may want to pack some cereal bars etc. as snacks.

Do not bring any unnecessary electronic devices as they may be lost. You may need a European travel adaptor to charge your phone. Students must be responsible for their belongings and be **very aware of pick pockets**.

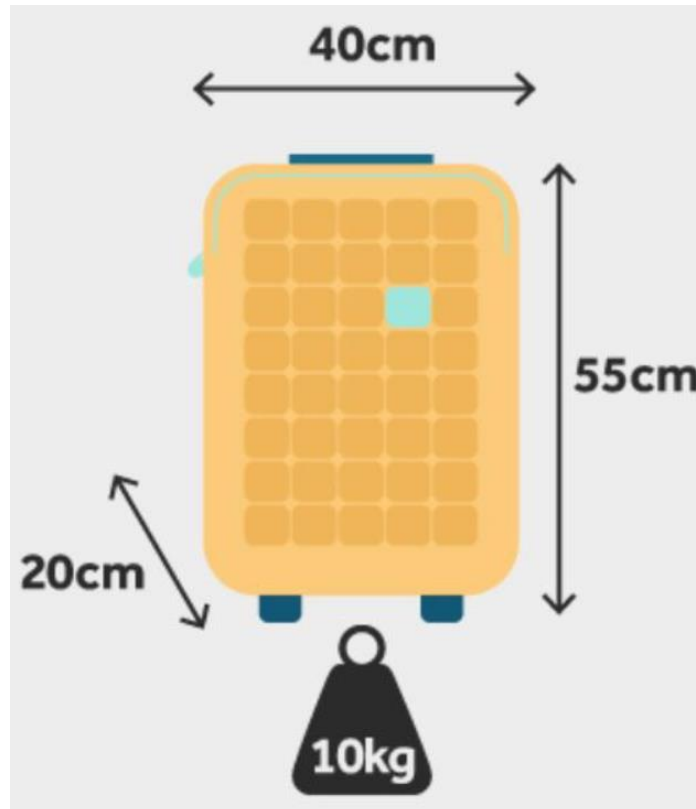

### What is not insured?

- ✗ Journeys which do not start and finish in the Republic of Ireland / United Kingdom.
- ✗ Pre-existing conditions which have not been declared for you or for your travelling companion/s (Unless on waived conditions list with the insured not awaiting surgery and that they are fully discharged from any post-operative follow up and any or all on going treatment or investigation).
- ✗ Cancellation to due to the known illness or pre-existing medical condition of a non-travelling immediate relative.
- ✗ Anything which may give rise to a claim which you were aware of at the time of travelling and/or purchasing cover.
- ✗ Sports and leisure activities not listed in the wording under the cover option you have purchased.
- ✗ Cover for winter sports
- ✗ Medical expenses over €650 unless authorised.
- ✗ Any excesses shown in the policy wording.
- ✗ Suicide, self-harm, reckless behaviour or act of self-exposure to danger, infection or injury (except to save human life).
- ✗ Malicious, fraudulent, dishonest or criminal acts by you or anyone acting on your behalf.
- ✗ Travelling against the advice of a medical practitioner, or to receive medical treatment, or if you do not take recommended treatment or prescribed medication.
- ✗ Problems caused by drug addiction or solvent a buse or being under the influence of alcohol or drug(s).
- ✗ Travel to any area or event which the Department of Foreign Affairs or the World Health Organisation or similar body has advised against all, or all but essential, travel.
- ✗ Traveling against any health requirements stipulated by the carrier, their handling agents or any other public transport provider.
- ✗ Any claims caused by or relating to COVID-19 or SARS-COV-2 or any mutation or variation of these. This applies to all sections of cover apart from Section 1 (Cancellation) sub-sections 6 (a)&(b), Section 2 (Curtalement) subsections 3 & 4 and Section 4 (Emergency Medical and Repatriation expenses)
