Class of 2023 – Leaving Certificate Results

Dear Parents/Guardians and Leaving Certificate Class of 2023,

As you know, on Friday 25th August, provisional Leaving Certificate Results will be released online. To clarify, **individual results are not being issued to schools**. They will be **issued directly to students via the Candidate Self Service Candidate Portal at 10.00 am**. Candidates can view their results and will also be able to save and/or print a Statement of Provisional Results.

Information regarding the examinations appeals procedure will follow on Microsoft Teams for all candidates. Information will also be available from on the Candidate Self-Service Portal.

Accessing support from Abbey Community College

To continue to support you, we have kept your 6th Year Team *Ms. Cummin's Year Head Group* and your Abbey Community College email address active until the end of September. We have already posted on this Team information from the State Examinations Commission (SEC), emailed to us this week. The Guidance Counsellors will be available via Teams to answer any queries/questions students may have regarding results.

Accessing support from other services

The wellbeing of the candidates who receive Leaving Certificate results will be supported through a number of additional measures.

- a) The SEC Candidate helpline will be available at 1800 111 135 or 1800 111 136 from 10 AM to 5PM from Friday 25 August to Monday 4 September including weekends. Outside of these hours queries may be emailed to candidateportal@examinations.ie This helpline is provided for queries relating to the Candidate Self Service Portal and the services provided through the portal.

- b) The National Parents and Students Leaving Certificate Helpline, at 1800 265 165, which is provided by the National Parents Council will be available on dates and times outlined in the table below for students to reach a guidance counsellor with any queries that they may have. This helpline will operate until after the CAO first round offers and is staffed by qualified guidance counsellors from the Institute of Guidance Counsellors.


