Class of 2024 – Leaving Certificate Results

Dear Parents/Guardians and Leaving Certificate Class of 2024,

As you know, on Friday 23rd August, provisional Leaving Certificate Results will be released online. To clarify, **individual results are not being issued to schools**. They will be **issued directly to students via the Candidate Self Service Candidate Portal (CSSP) at 10.00 am**. Candidates can view their results and will also be able to save and/or print a Statement of Provisional Results.

Information regarding the examinations appeals procedure will issue by email from the State Examinations Commission (SEC) to all candidates registered on the Candidate Self Service Portal (CSSP). Information will also be available on www.examinations.ie

Accessing support from other services

The wellbeing of the candidates who receive Leaving Certificate results will be supported through a number of additional measures.

- b) The *Leaving Certificate Candidate Helpline*, at 1800 265 165, which is provided by the National Parents Council Post-Primary will be available on dates and times outlined in the table below for students to reach a guidance counsellor with any queries that they may have. This helpline will operate until after the CAO first round offers and is staffed by qualified guidance counsellors.
