Dear Parent/Guardian,

Third year students will attend a trip to **Emerald Park (formerly Tayto Park) on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> May 2025**. The cost of the trip is €60. This cost covers the bus, access to the park (all attractions included) and a hot meal in the park (nuggets and chips).

The bus will depart the school at 8:00am sharp and will leave Emerald Park at 5:00pm to travel back to Abbey Community College for 7:00pm.

To secure a place on the trip, **a deposit of €20 is required by 12<sup>th</sup> February 2025**.

**Methods of payment:**

- Way2Pay – a link is sent to the mobile phone to make payment which is updated instantly on the Way2Pay system (this is the fastest and most convenient way to pay the fee). The link will be sent to the mobile on 31/01/25.
- By card payment to the school bursar:
  - Times: Monday - Friday 8.30am – 12.30pm.

- By cheque / postal order made payable to Kilkenny Carlow ETB

Students will be required to wear their PE or school uniform on the trip.
