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Dear Parent / Guardian,

The Transition Year students will be travelling to Delphi Adventure Centre, Co. Mayo from 7th – 9th April 2025.

Departure: 7.30 am **sharp** Monday April 7th 2025

Return: Between 4.00 – 5.00 pm Wednesday April 9th 2025

Students will need to bring a packed lunch for Monday and any snacks they require. Dinner, breakfast and lunch will be provided for Tuesday and Wednesday. As we will be embarking on a very long bus journey to and from the venue, we discourage the use of fizzy drinks and junk snacks/food.

Students need to pack appropriate clothes suitable for Irish weather! Please see recommendation for packing as outlined in the Delphi Adventure Centre parent/guardian information which will be distributed to students via their *Year Group Team* closer to the departure date. Students **are required to wear their school PE uniform**. They will be participating in outdoor activities where they will get wet and dirty. Please do not bring good clothes or valuables. Teachers are not responsible for personal items or money belonging to the students.

All school rules, as outlined in our school's *Code of Behaviour*, must be adhered to at all times. Students must comply with all instructions given by teachers and instructors while on the adventure. Any serious breach of the school's *Code of Behaviour* will result in the student having to be collected immediately by a parent/guardian. **Please read and discuss the [Code of Behaviour](#) with your son/daughter.**

In particular please note the following: Any misuse of mobile phones or personal electronic devices will be dealt with under the **Mobile Phone, and Personal Electronic Device Acceptable Use Policy** and our **Code of Behaviour**.
